A look back...

2018 Year at a Glance:

	General Fund Budgeted	Actual
Income	\$732,950	\$767,429
Expenses	\$781,740	\$776,802
Excess Income (Expense)	(\$ 48,790)	\$ (9,373)
Fund Balance Beginning	\$19,373	\$19,373
Fund Balance Ending	\$19,373	\$10,000*

*This was carried over into 2019 to start the year off. It is optimal to have a carryover for unplanned shortages of revenue or excess unplanned expenses.

We were able to pay the budgeted Connectional Support of 5% in 2018. It is our goal to increase each year until we can reach the requested 11% by our Conference Office.

In order to meet budget in 2018, we had to draw only \$3,334 from our Unity and Diversity restricted fund.

FUMC Dictionary

Connectional Support = FUMC's denominational obligation to pay a 10% tithe to the Indiana Conference Office and 1% toward our District Office.

General Fund = FUMC's annual operating budget. Helps fund the daily operations of the church and special ministries, missions, and committees.

Trustees Property Fund = for non-routine facility and capital expenses, including the loan to replace the roof in 2013.
